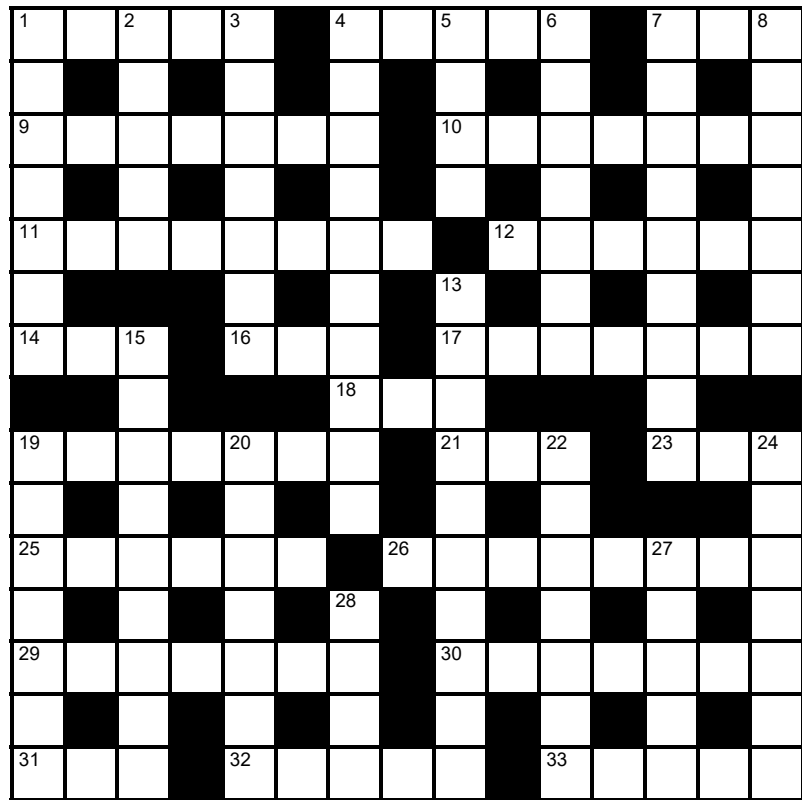


Visible among the across solutions are the partial names of four characters and the title of the TV programme they were in. Count the instances in the completed grid of the letter mentioned in that title.
