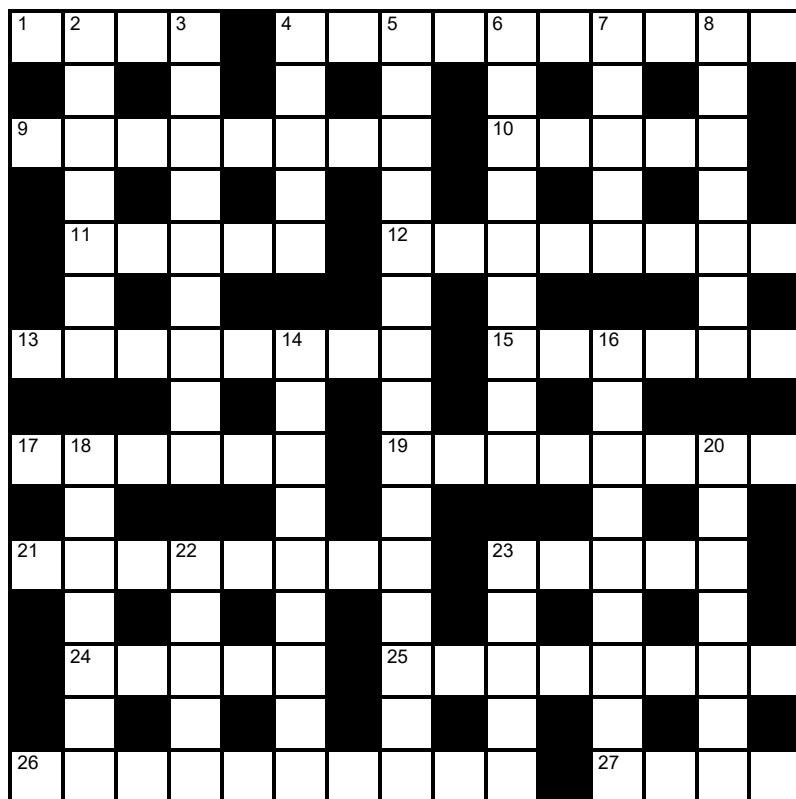


Thinking Laterally
