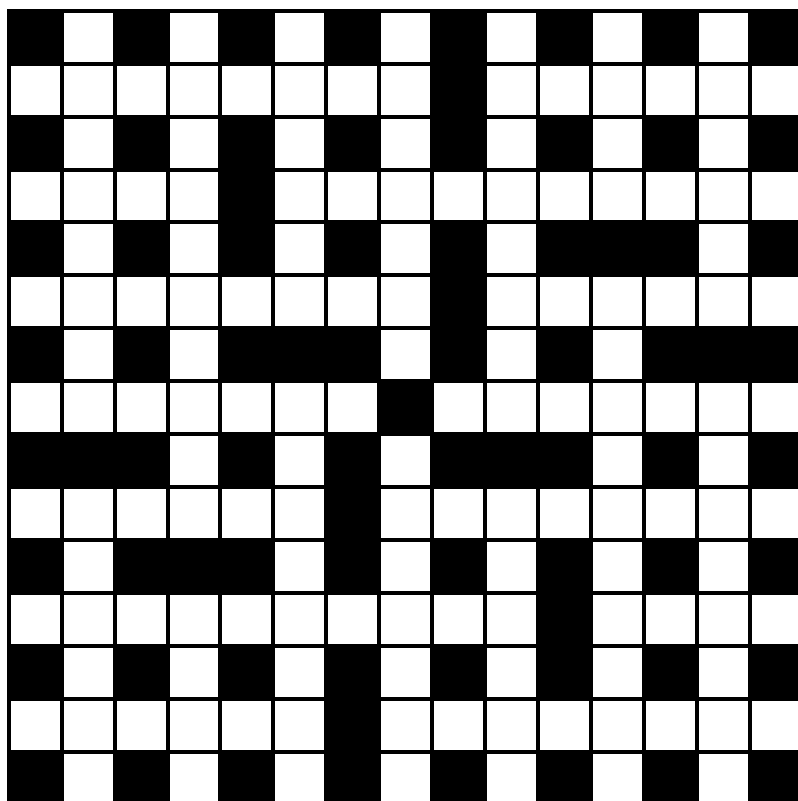


**York S&B 2019**
